Individuals with Disabilities Act

Ages Eligible

Eligibility Criteria

Student must qualify in one of the 13 categories of disability, AND disability affects the child's ability to access curriculum.

Student must have a disability AND the disability affects the student's participation in daily life

activities

Written Plan

Does require a written plan with required components followed specific timelines

Does not **require** a written plan

Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act

Evaluation

and requalified every three years

assessment tools. Student must be re-evaluated

Initial evaluation required using standard

Does not specify evaluation procedures; simply states "periodic" evaluation

Parent Involvement

Parents are required to be part of the IEP team from evaluation, through each part of the process

School must get permission to do evaluation. School can create a plan without parent participation.

Resolving Disagreements

Procedural safeguards, due process outlined by law

Limited



504

Curriculum

Must include specially designed instruction to meet student's unique educational needs

Curriculum is not customized for the student. The student completes the same curriculum as students without disabilities.

Annual Review

least once a year, the child's grown ups can request a review at any time

Goals must be written, measurable, and reviewed

The law requires that a plan must be reviewed at

The law does not require the school to review

Accommodations can be made to academics. curriculum, assessments, environment, and more No goals or progress monitoring

Students can have modified assignments and/or
